

## Auto-Setup



Restarting auto set-up will retune the unit and will find all of the TV stations currently being received. It will also reset the time and date. Unlike Shipping condition, no other settings will be affected.



## Auto-Setup Continued...



### Auto-set-up Begins....





- All previous settings are erased.
- The analogue settings are downloaded to a Q-Link compatible equipment connected to the TV.
- When the operation is completed, the digital service at programme position "1" will be displayed.
  If no DVB services are found, the first analogue service will be displayed.

The process will take between 3 and 5 minutes to complete. Please do not press any button until complete.

A TV station will appear when once tuning has finished.
